ANNUAL REPORT-2014-15

A momentous year has been appended to the glorious history of Future Bhubaneswar School. This year has been hallmarked by many a noteworthy events. As pilgrims towards perfection, we have crossed few more milestones in the bygone academic year.

Academics

Academic excellence tops our list of priorities and we leave nothing to chance to achieve the same. The first batch of students will appear at the Class X Board Examination in March, 2015. CCE is strictly enforced as per CBSE regulations. Regular formative and summative assessments form class VI to IX and observations in classes I to V keep a tab on the academic progress of students. English remains the language on the campus, but at the same time, other languages are not neglected. Remedial coaching extended to the fringe of slow learners has started paying dividends. There is palpable improvement in their academic performance though there is always scope for further improvement. All the teachers are trained and 90% of them are postgraduates. The ambience is student friendly and constant efforts are being made to customize learning. 15 of our teachers participated in the CCE & FA Training conducted by CBSE empanelled agency in the school on 28th and 29th September, 2014. 7 of our teachers attended various training programmes. Most of the children regularly participate in National English, Science, Mathematics and Cyber Olympiads and do extremely well.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Independence Day was observed with traditional gaiety and fervour. This was the occasion when patriotic feelings ruled the roost. On Teachers' day, children paid due homage to their teachers in a befitting manner. On Children's day, the role was almost reversed. Teachers performed for the children. Children are bundles of talents. In conducive and congenial atmosphere, they bloom into

excellent artists, writers, poets and sportsmen and women. We do have talents galore. The sports meet on 22nd & 23rd December, 2013 witnessed all the children vying for honours in various events. An educational tour to Ansupa and nearby sites on 6th of November, 2014 helped the children to siphon off the pressure of learning. On 6th of October 2014, a science exhibition held in the school premises tickled the scientific sensibilities of the children. As a part of ecological awareness building, around 30 children visited Mangajodi in Chilka where they could witness wetland conservation and protection of migratory birds from poachers undertaken by local people. It was organized by Social Service Wing of XIMB. A dental Camp for students was conducted by doctors from KIMS and General Check-up camp by doctors from Sakha, a social service organization from Cuttack in February, 2014.

School has become a member of CBSE Sahodya Complex, Bhubaneswar Chapter and do participate in various competitions held under its banner. Annual Day was celebrated on 22nd December, 2013. Shri. Ranjib Biswal, Chairman IPL, was the Chief Guest, Shri. Akash Das Nayak, Eminent Cine Artist and Shri. Sanjeev Nayak, Trustee, Future Focus Initiative were the Guests of honour. Annual Literary and Sports and Games merit certificates were distributed to the winners on the occasion. The cultural extravaganza that followed added colour to the soiree.

Student Strength

The student strength rose from 245 to 333. There are 24 teachers excluding the Principal and nearly 15 support staff including security staff.

Infrastructure Development.

Full-fledged Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer labs have been set up. The afore-said labs are enough to meet the requirement up to Class XII.

Transport & New Furniture

Two more new buses were added to existing fleet as students availing conveyance facility increased. 50 Triple-seater bench-desk combo have been added to the existing stock of furniture and three more class rooms have been equipped with new furniture. Currently, we have seating capacity for 600 students.

Library

The library is well-stocked and has around 3500 books on various subjects. Nearly 500 more books are added to the stock. Books are issued to the children regularly.

Computer Lab

The computer lab has been reinforced with 10 more new computers.

Indoor Sports room Play ground

The indoor sports room is equipped with table tennis, caroms and chess boards. Playground includes a football court, a volleyball court, two badminton courts and a kho-kho court.

Dance-music Room

A room is exclusively meant for dance and music. This helps in fine-tuning the artistic temperament of students. Aptitude for arts has an important place in CCE. Dance and music classes are held on all Wednesdays invariably. Musical instruments such as harmonium, tabla, keyboard etc. are available in the school.

Open Stage Auditorium

An open stage auditorium, for the smooth conduct of school functions, has been constructed adjacent to the playground and it is spacious enough to accommodate a crowd of 3000 plus people.

Yoga, Self-defense training, Public Speaking, SUPW etc.

Weekly yoga classes help the children to master the art self-discipline. Similarly, class on self-defense on Fridays gives tips on self-protection. Public Speaking rids the students of stage fright. Clubs such as News Reading, Nature, Art, Science etc. help the children to nurture the

aptitude they have which in turn might prove a boon in future. The first issue of Afflatus, school quarterly was released on 31st January, 2014. Spadework is done to introduce Scouts and Guides in school.
